

Inspection of the overload protections (DGUV 54)

Seminar objective

The German statutory accident insurance requires compliance with the accident prevention provision DGUV 54 (formerly BGV D8) by an annually renewed inspection of the pulling winch.

Operators of pulling winches and experts (comparable to § 2 BetrSichV).
